**Behavior Expectations for Scouts, Boy Scouts of America - Troop 925**

Boy Scouts are expected to exemplify a higher level of personal discipline and social behavior than other boys and society in general. Behaviors unworthy of a Scout and behaviors generally not acceptable in society will not be tolerated in Troop 925. Improper behavior may result in the Scout being suspended from the event. If suspended, the Scout's parent(s)/guardian will be responsible for picking up their son from the event.
